Missoula County Outdoor Burning to be CLOSED as of July 1st

June 27th 2017, Missoula, Montana – Fire officials with the Missoula County Fire Protection Association (MCFPA) have restricted debris burning (open burning) starting Saturday July 1st.

The weather forecast calls for continued hot dry days with temperatures in the high 80's and mid 90's this week and next. People who burned this spring should go check on their piles to make sure they are fully extinguished. While there are no other restrictions at this time, we urge people to be careful with fires and double check before recreating in Montana. Visit www.firerestrictions.us for more information.
